A celebration

This beautiful book by Peter Bassett has been published to mark the bicentenary of the births of Richard Wagner and Giuseppe Verdi whose works continue to enrich the lives of opera lovers everywhere. They were born at a time when Europe was convulsed by the Napoleonic wars, and when the nation states of Germany and Italy did not yet exist. Each became a master of musical-dramatic forms and transformed the way music was composed for the theatre. Their influence extended well beyond the stage. Peter Bassett's new study of these two great figures of the nineteenth century is richly illustrated in full colour with art works drawn from opera houses, museums and private collections. It features insightful commentaries and magnificent photographs of locations associated with the composers and their works. It has been printed by Hyde Park Press, Adelaide on high quality art paper and runs to 232 pages in large format.
